We will be reading *The Tiger Who Came To Tea*.



In our writing we will be learning to:

- Use capital letters, finger spaces and full stops
- Write captions
- Write non-fiction sentences
- Make lists

Maths

We will be learning to:

- Recognise numbers to 10
- Familiarise ourselves with number bonds to 10 (pairs of numbers that make 10)
- Addition and subtraction within 10.

Spelling/Phonics

- Children will be learning and applying phonic knowledge in their writing and reading.
- Children will begin to learn Year 1 common exception words.

Geography

In Geography we will be learning to draw or read a simple picture map.

Understand how a key is used to show features on a map.

Art

We will create animal patterns using different media.

Music

In Music we will be learning to tap pulse and rhythm. We will explore pitch and percussion instruments.

We will listen to music related to animals (*Carnival of the Animals* and *Peter and the Wolf*).
