English

We will be reading *Stig of the Dump*



In our writing we will be learning to:

- Describe a special person
- Write a warning story
- Write a chronological report

Maths

We will be learning to:

- Understand place value in numbers up to 1000.
- Develop our understanding of all four operations (addition, subtraction, multiplication and division).
- Continue to learn our multiplication tables.

Spelling/Phonics

- Some of us will be continuing with daily Read Write Inc. lessons.
- Some of us will have a weekly spelling list of words to learn.



In the Through the Ages project, your child will learn about three different periods of British prehistory: Stone Age, Bronze Age and Iron Age. They will discover terminology relating to time and sequence dates to make a timeline. They explore the changes to people, homes and lifestyle throughout the different periods and investigate examples of prehistoric settlements, monuments, burials and artefacts in detail. They will also study how technology improved over time, including how the discovery of different metals changed the way that people lived.

History/Geography

In history we will be learning to develop our understanding of chronology. We will learn about British Pre-History from the Stone-Age to the Iron-Age.
