Literacy

In our writing we will be learning to:

- Create marks in different media such as shaving foam or paint.
- Experiment with writing to give meaning to our drawings.
- Attempt to write initial letters of familiar words.
- Make clearly identifiable letters when writing
- Write meaningful sentences

Maths

We will be learning to:

- Enjoy and take part in number songs
- Use number names in play
- Write numbers 1-10
- Recognise numbers 1-10.
- Subitise numbers
- Adding and subtracting numbers up to 20.
- Recognise shapes and their properties.

Spelling/Phonics

We will continue learning phonics through Read Write Inc. and Attention Autism (bucket).

Some of us will have a weekly spelling list of words to learn.

Our focus this term will be based on the question: What happens when I fall asleep? We will explore other questions such as Why are there stars in the sky at night? Does everyone go to bed at the same time as me? We will share our own experiences of night time, our bedtime routines and learn about animals that sleep different to us; those that are nocturnal and those that hibernate.

Thrive

We will be learning to find different ways that will help us deal with different emotions such as excited, sad and angry and begin to support our friends to use them when needed.

At home you could...

Have a go at some fine motor skills activities such as threading or using pegs to pick up small objects such as pasta to support pencil grip.

Remember to read daily.

Understanding the world

We will be learning to use our experiences to talk about significant events that are important to use such as how we celebrate Christmas. We will also observe closely what animals do as the weather and season changes.

Art and Design

In art we will be learning to use different media, tools and techniques to enhance our experiences of night time, sleep and nocturnal animals.

PE

In PE we will be learning to develop and master basic movements including running, jumping, throwing and catching.

Cooking

In cooking we will be learning about recipes and following recipes to make simple meals.

Forest School

In Forest School we will be learning about nocturnal and hibernating animals.

Communication and Language

We will continue to practise using more complex sentences including words such as 'because' and 'and'. We will be extending our vocabulary using topic words such as nocturnal, hibernation, constellations, light and dark. We will also be focusing on our targets that have specifically come from SALT.
