In our writing we will be learning to:

Maths

Next term, whilst most children continue their learning at home, we will continue learning about numbers within 50 and their place value. We will also begin our learning about addition and subtraction within 50

Although we are not sure on a date that schools will reopen, when children do return to school, we are initially planning to focus our teaching on place value, addition/subtraction and multiplication/division. Securing these skills will ensure children have a good foundation of skills to apply to other areas of Maths.

Spelling/Phonics

Children will be learning and applying phonic knowledge in their writing and reading.

Children will continue to learn their year group common exception words, and will practise and be tested in school weekly.

Splendid Skies

Imagine floating high above land and sea on a bed of clouds, silently sweeping by on a billowing breeze. Back down to earth, let's take a walk outdoors. But what should we wear? Wellington boots? A sun hat? Maybe a warm coat? How do we know what the weather will be like today? If you don't like today's weather report, why not write your own? Make a weather station to find out more about the weather in your area. What weather do you prefer? Sunshine, snow, storms or showers?

Get your wellies on and let's go.

Science

We will identify and name common plants and explore the basic structure of common flowers. We will learn about seasonal changes and explore shadows as well as the effect of sunlight on different objects. We will use thermometers to measure air temperature and rain gauges to measure rainfall.



Art and Design

We will explore and create weather themed art work, including cloud art, season trees and sun catchers. We will look at artist Berndnaut Smilde's moving cloud installations and explore ways to make temporary clouds.



Geography

We will investigate patterns in the weather and learn about extreme weather in the UK. We will locate the equator and the North and South Pole and will learn about the climate in these places.

History

We will learn about Sir Francis Beaufort and how he developed the wind speed scale.

Music

We will be exploring different types of music and discussing the instruments we can hear, the rhythm and if we like or dislike the music. We will also create our own dance routines to the music using the beat to guide us!

PE

Our emphasis this term is 'Fitness and Fun'. We want to continue developing a love for physical activity as well as specifically focusing on the skills of jumping and balancing. We will do this through a range of fun games and activities.

RE

We will hear parables from the Bible and explore Christian beliefs about God. We will learn about the different ways that Christians pray.
