English

We will share lots of wonderful texts...







In our writing we will be learning to:

- Write a story based on The Gigantic Turnip;
- Write a recount of our trip;
- Write sentences about the Platinum Jubilee
- Use punctuation in the correct places.

Maths

We will be:

- Counting in 2s, 5s and 10s
- Continuing to work on place value in 2 digit numbers and using addition and subtraction
- Introducing sharing and simple division.
- Finding halves and quarters of shapes and numbers.

Spelling/Phonics

Children will be continuing to apply phonic knowledge in their writing and reading.

Children will continue to learn Year 1 common exception words, and will practise and be tested in school weekly.



Term 5

This term we are exploring plants, animals and their habitats and the Jubilee!

We will be starting off with an exciting trip to Westonbirt, where we will explore a variety of habitats and how the animals that live there adapt to their environment.

The we will be thinking about seeds, what they need to grow and what they might turn in to. Finally, we will be learning all about the Queen's Jubilee and understanding why it is an important event!

Science

We will visit Westonbirt Arboretum and through our learning, discover that the local environment is a habitat for living things and can change during the seasons. We will grow plants from seeds and label and describe basic parts of plants, using the book "It Starts with a Seed" as a starting point.

Computing

We will be using a computer to create and format text, before comparing to writing non-digitally. We will practice finding and using the keys on a keyboard in order to create digital content, then formatting our writing using tools.

PSHE

Our focus this term is "Being My Best". We will talk about eating healthy foods, keeping clean and exercising.

Music

We will enjoy the following:

- Listening to and Appraising the song Your Imagination and other songs about using our imaginations
- Musical Activities learning and/or building on our knowledge and understanding about the interrelated dimensions of music
- Performing the Song performing and share our learning

PE

In P.E. this term, we will develop our fundamental movement skills. We will learn to strike a stationary ball with accuracy

RF

We will learn to empathise with Jewish children by understanding what they do during Shabbat and why it is important to them.

History

We will learn about the Platinum Jubilee and Queen Elizabeth II's coronation. We will consider why this was an important event in history.

Geography

We will learn about London as the Capital city of England and learn to identify some of its landmarks.
