English

In our writing we will be learning to:

- Write recount sentences about The Platinum Jubilee

- Create and answer a range of written questions
- Begin to refine our handwriting by practising letter joins

Maths


We will:

- Continue to work with equal groups when multiplying and dividing.
- Find halves and quarters of shapes and numbers.
- Look at place value of numbers up to 100.
- Explore money and time

Spelling/Phonics

Children will be continuing to apply phonic knowledge in their writing and reading.

Children will continue to learn Year 1 common exception words, and will practise and be tested in school weekly.



Term 6

This term we will be continuing our learning about Queen Elizabeth's Platinum Jubilee and London as capital city of England.

We will be reflecting on what we have seen and heard over the special bank holiday. We will learn to recognise some landmarks in London and understand how cities like Bath and London are different to towns like Melksham.

Finally, we will take a trip to Bath to spend time in a city – we will look for landmarks and have a picnic too!

Geography

We will learn to:

- Name and locate the four countries of the UK and their capital cities on a map, atlas or globe
- Identify the similarities and differences between two places
- Identify features and landmarks on aerial photographs

Computing

The children will learn on-screen programming through Scratch Jr. We will explore the way a project looks by investigating sprites and backgrounds. We will use programming blocks to use, modify, and create programs. The children will also be introduced to the early stages of program design through the introduction of algorithms.

PSHE:

We will learn all about how to Be our Best and how we are Growing and Changing. We will also enjoy a visit on the Life Bus.

Music

We will enjoy the following:

- Listening and Appraising Classical music
- Continuing to embed the foundations of the interrelated dimensions of music using voices and instruments
- Singing
- Playing instruments within the song
- Improvisation using voices and instruments
- Composition
- Sharing and performing the learning that has taken place

PF

In P.E. this term, we will be developing our fundamental skills and preparing for Sports Day. We will develop an effective running technique as well as learning about sportsmanship, accepting and celebrating winners.

RE

We are learning to empathise with Jewish children by learning about what Rosh Hashanah and Yom Kippur mean to them.

DT

- We will design make and evaluate a fruit kebab as a healthy snack
- We will design, make and evaluate a book which includes paper sliders and levers.

Science

We will learn that everyday materials include wood, plastic, glass, metal, water, rock, brick, paper and fabric.

We will learn that materials have different properties such as hard or soft, stretchy or stiff, rough or smooth, opaque or transparent, bendy or rigid.
