We will be reading 'The True Story of the Three Little Pigs' by Jon Scieska.



Our class readers will be 'In Every House on Every Street' by Jess Hitchman and 'The Street Beneath my Feet' by Charlotte Guillian.
Our writing will be a narrative based on the 'True Story of the Three Little Pigs'. We will also be writing instructions on how perform a dance and a Kennings poem linked to animals.

Maths

We will focus on addition and subtraction, starting to look at adding two-digit numbers together, as well as subtracting two-digit numbers. We will begin to cross 10 in our addition and subtraction, and deepen our understanding of place value through work on mental and practical strategies.

Spelling/Phonics/Grammar

We will be learning more spelling rules which we can use in our English writing. Children will continue learning phonics in their reading groups.

What's around our school?

Let's learn about our local community, looking at houses old and new and finding out how our streets have changed since our mums and dads were young. Make maps and plans of the streets around us, planning our routes. What can you see? What can we find? Whereabouts do you live? Do you know your address? We will find out how to write instructions and directions as well as taking a walk through Melksham, from the school to St Michael's church and back again. We will also be thinking about our community and the people around us.

Science

In science, we will be continuing to learn about animals including humans – focusing on the things animals need to survive and a healthy, balanced diet.



Geography

In Geography, we will use simple fieldwork and observational skills to study the geography of our school and its grounds. We will also the key human and physical features of its surrounding environment.

Computing

In Computing, we will be using devices to capture photographs. Children will learn to recognise that different devices can be used to capture photographs and will gain experience capturing, editing, and improving photos. Finally, they will use this knowledge to recognise that images they see may not be real.

Music

In Music this term, pupils will work towards preparing for their Christmas Nativity. They will sing songs and learn the actions.

D&T

In D&T this term, we are looking at mechanisms. We will design, create and evaluate a carnival float to recreate our town carnival.

PSHE

In PSHE we will be learning about keeping safe, who we can go to for help and how we can keep ourselves safe in person and online.

RF

We are learning to reflect on the Christmas story and the importance of Jesus's birth for Christianity and Christian people.
