NSPCC

I am pleased to say that whilst some children were outside for sports day, those inside were participating in the NSPCC's Speak out. Stay safe. Programme. Speak out. Stay safe. is a programme for children aged 5-11 which aims to help children understand abuse in all its forms and to recognise the signs of abuse, in an age appropriate manner. Children are taught to speak out if they are worried, either to a safe adult or Childline. This is a yearly programme that we participate in, and have done so for many years.

This child friendly programme is aligned with the curriculum and consists of age appropriate virtual assemblies and supporting classroom based activities. Summer Reading Challenge 2023

This is a great opportunity to keep reading all through the summer, so sign up and join in!!

Sign up for this year's <u>Summer Reading Challenge</u>. Sign up at Melksham Community library from **15 July.**

What is the Summer Reading Challenge?

The challenge is for 4–11-year-olds to read 6 library books over 8 weeks of the summer in return for various fun prizes, including a medal and certificate on completion.

This year the challenge runs from Saturday **15 July to Saturday 9 September**. There will be an initial registration period in the first two weeks of the challenge, where children will receive a collector's folder, then after this period (from 31 July) they are invited to return to talk about the books they have read and start collecting their stickers. Children can also continue to register throughout the summer.

It's **FREE** to take part, and last year 75% of children taking part improved their reading skills over the holidays.

Why should my child sign up?

- They will be better prepared to return to school in the autumn.
- Becoming more independent in their reading boosts children's confidence and self-esteem.
- The library provides **free access** to books and fun family activities all through the summer.
- Library staff are on hand to offer support and book recommendations.

Your child will be part of a UK-wide programme developed by <u>The Reading Agency</u> and delivered in partnership with the <u>public library network</u>.

How can my child take part? (Library or online)

It's **FREE** to join the challenge and to take out a library membership, visit: <u>Join the library - Wiltshire</u> <u>Council</u> and library staff will be on hand to support reading choices. Children can also take part in the challenge online via the website: <u>Summer Reading Challenge</u> where they can rate and review books, download activities, and access video content, games and quizzes.

Attendance the last data (week 30/6/23) shows

School overall 94.1% compared to National 91.2% - Keep it up every child, every day!!

You MUST inform the school of your child's absence if you as the parent are unwell you are expected to find support to ensure your children are at school and on time.

Check your Arbor App, what % is your child's attendance??? if it is below 90% you may well be asked to attend a meeting at school to discuss this

Any term time holidays will be denied and any overall unauthorised absences that mean your child has accumulated 10 sessions will also be considered for a fine, this is a legal process and the school does not receive this money

NEW Prices for Services - from 01/09/2023

Due to many costs rising such as energy and food we have needed to review the charges we make for our traded services. We have tried to keep this increase to a minimum, as we do appreciate that our families are also battling with all these increased costs.

From 1st September 2023, the prices for the following services will be as follows:

- Nursery: Half Day (3.75hrs) £21.80. Full Day (7.5hrs) £43.75. Nursery Breakfast £4.65
- Meals: Cost per meal £2.70
- Before School Club: Cost per session £2.55
- After School Club to 4:15: Cost per session £1.75
- Lettings: Hall (per hour, min 1.5hrs) £12.00. Kingfisher Court Weekdays £12.00.
 Kingfisher Court Weekends £18.00
- Music Lessons: £8.00 per 15 min individual lesson, or a 30 min group session
